Who is a volunteer?

An individual who participates in AKC® events without compensation and helps with event operations, such as:

- Event coordination
- Registration
- Event setup/tear-down
- Leash running
- Hospitality
- Ring stewarding
- Coaching
- Ring crew

Volunteers may assist AKC® event participants, staff organizers or members, but they cannot be involved in any business activities associated with the event. Additionally, volunteers cannot run a private business that offers these types of activities.

What coverage options are available?

1 Tier I – Basic protection:

- General liability and accident coverage for one individual only
- Included activities/roles:
 - Check-in or hospitality
 - Gate or ring steward
 - Scribe
 - Timer, award presenter or score runner
 - Leash runners
 - Inspections
 - Ring crew
- Annual premium: \$225

2 Tier II – Expanded coverage:

- General liability, accident coverage and professional liability for one individual
- Includes activities/roles in Tier I, plus the following activities/roles:
 - Coach
 - Course builder or setup
 - Event coordinator
 - Ring coordinator
- Annual premium: \$275

What are the program highlights?

- Availability to add spouses and partners for an additional premium
- Declaration of dates is not necessary
- Care, custody and control included
- \$500,000/\$1,000,000 (occurrence/aggregate) limits
- AD+D limit: \$10,000
- Excess accident medical limit: \$25,000
